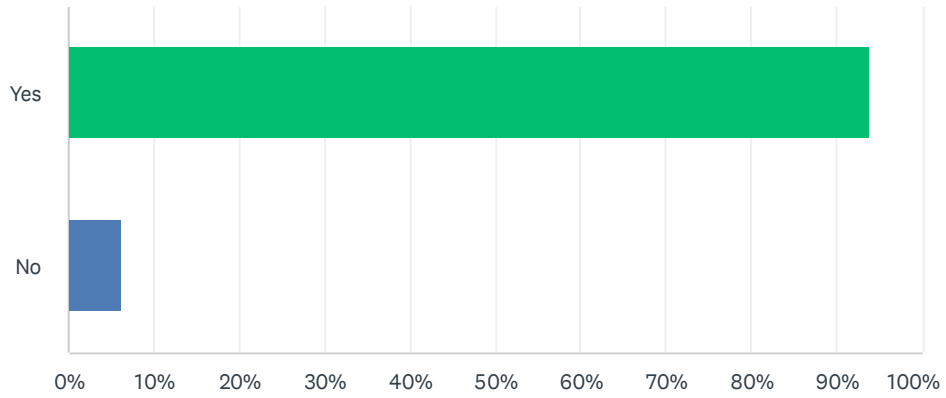


# Q1 Do you plan to enroll in Fall 2023 Semester classes?

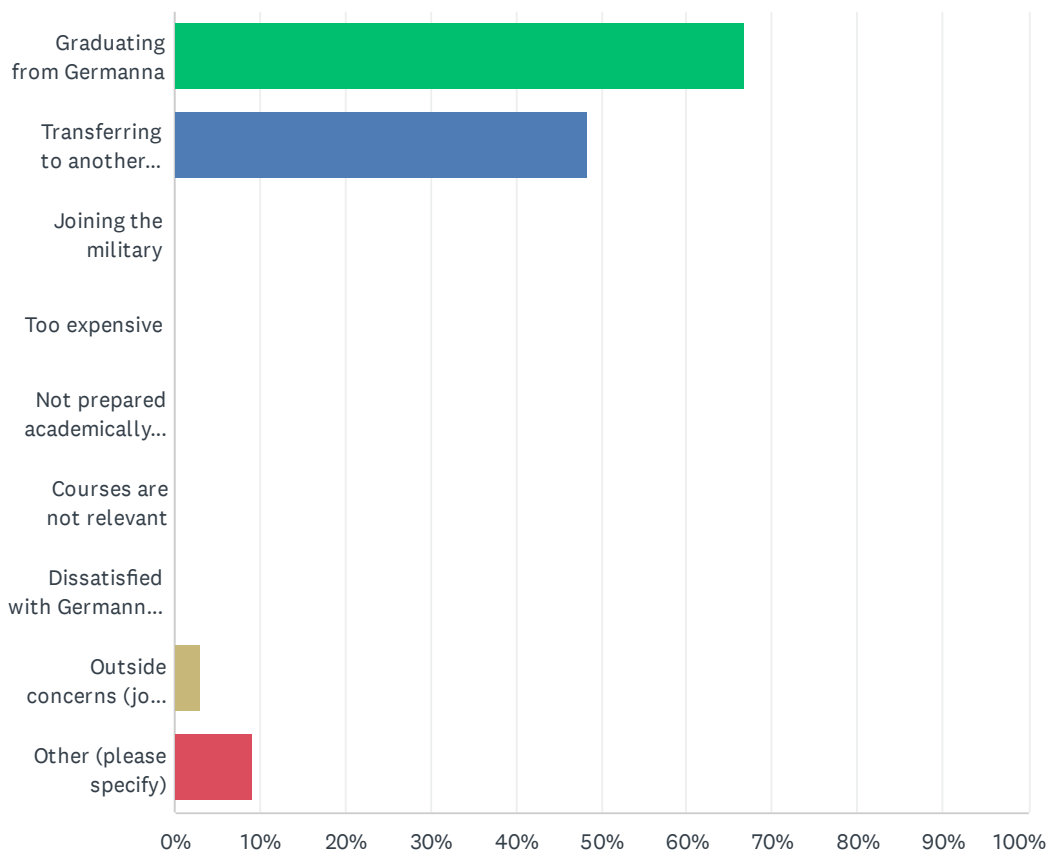

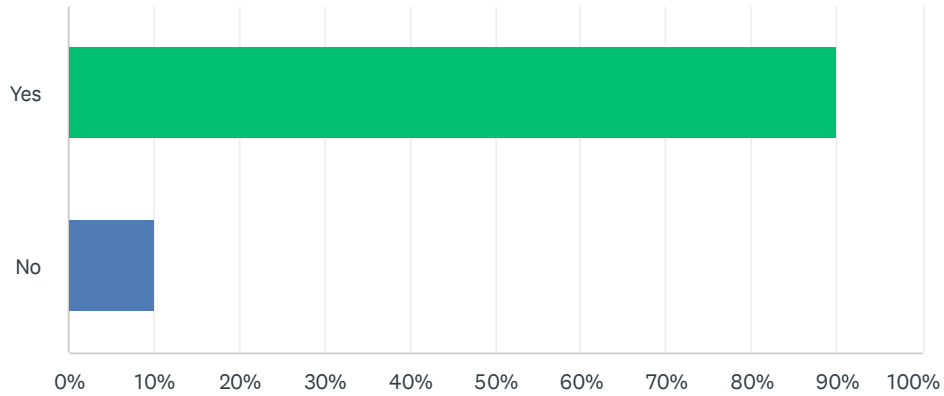

### Q3 During the Spring 2023 semester, were you able to enroll in the classes you needed?

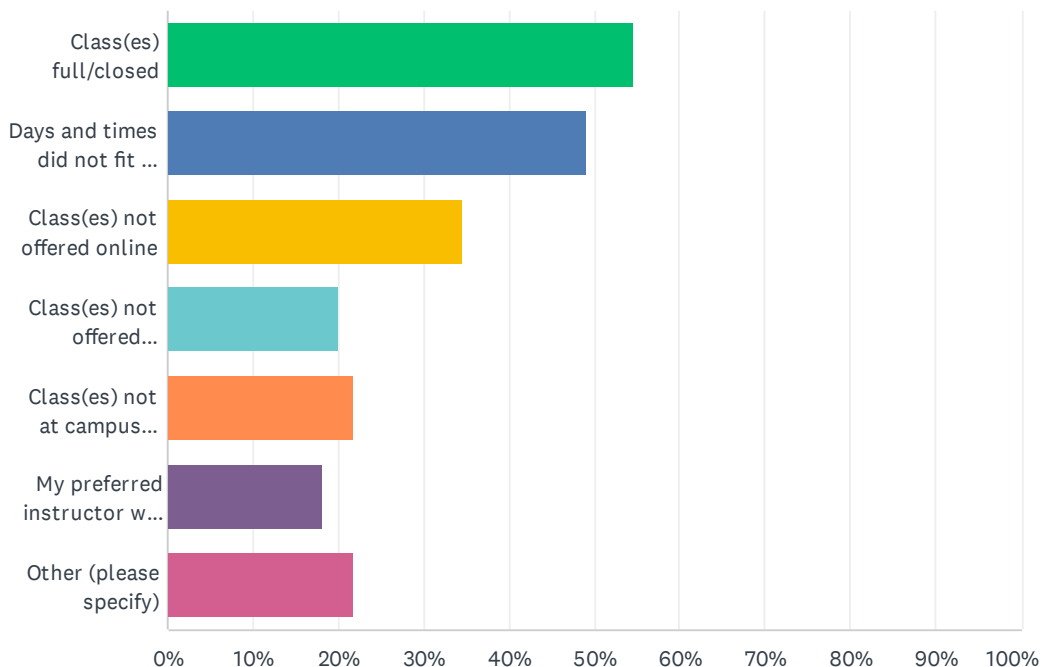

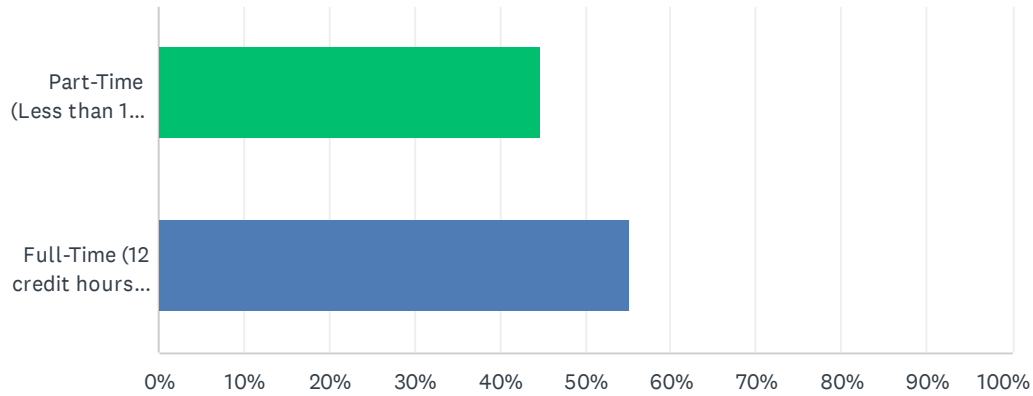

## Q5 How do you plan to attend the Fall 2023 semester?

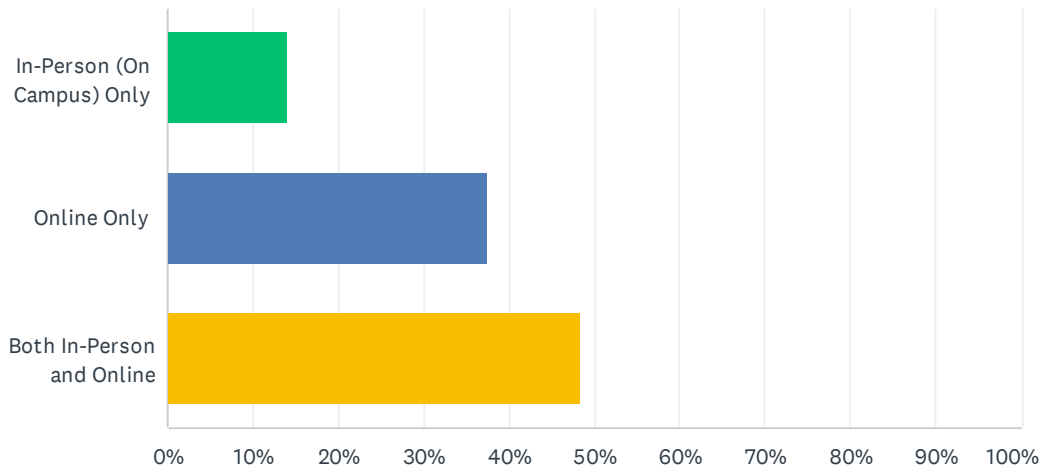

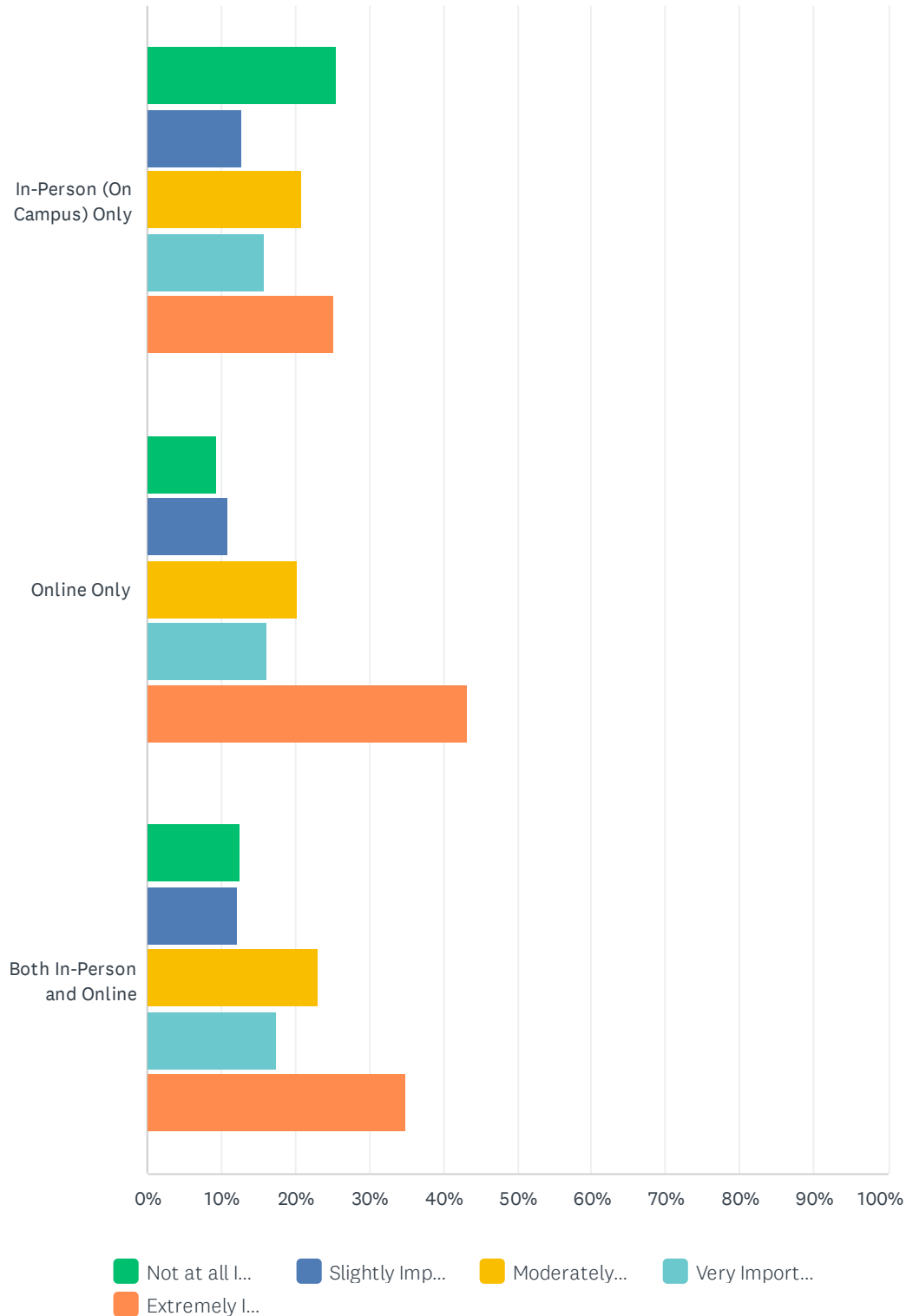

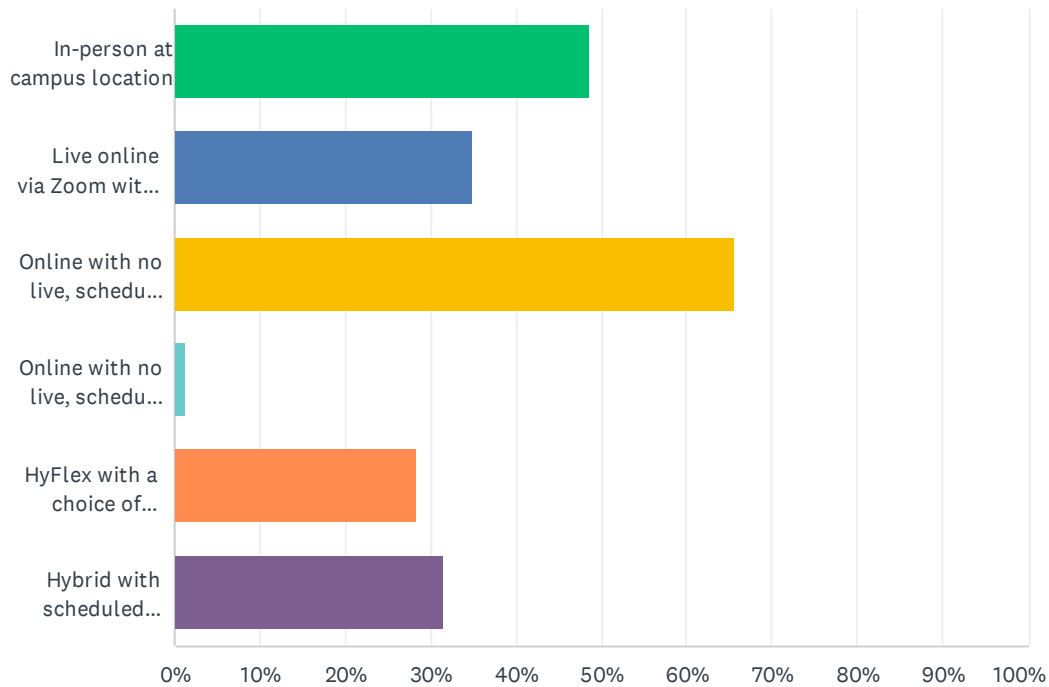

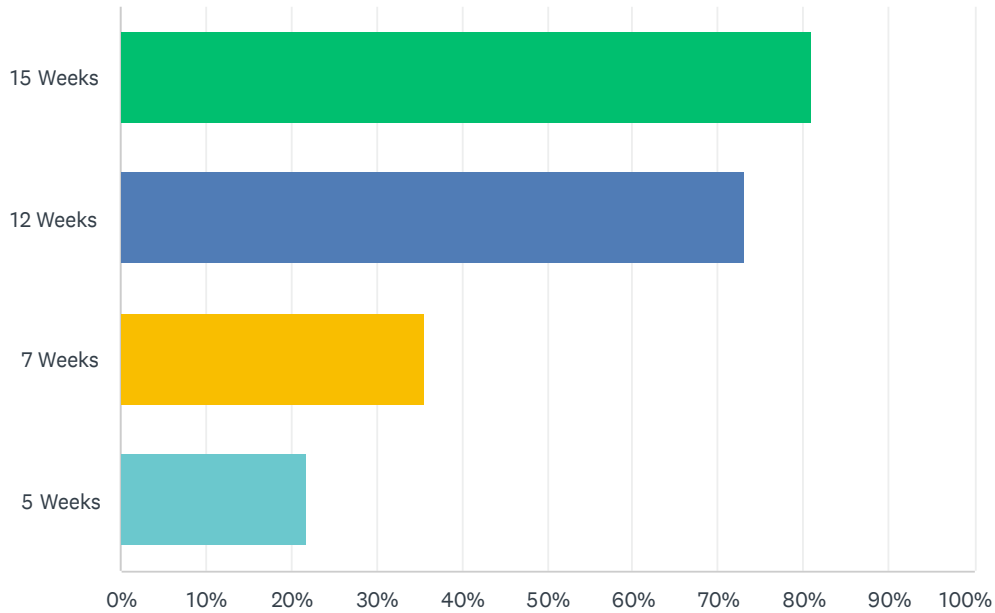

### Q9 Which offerings for course length would you consider if available? (Select all that apply.)

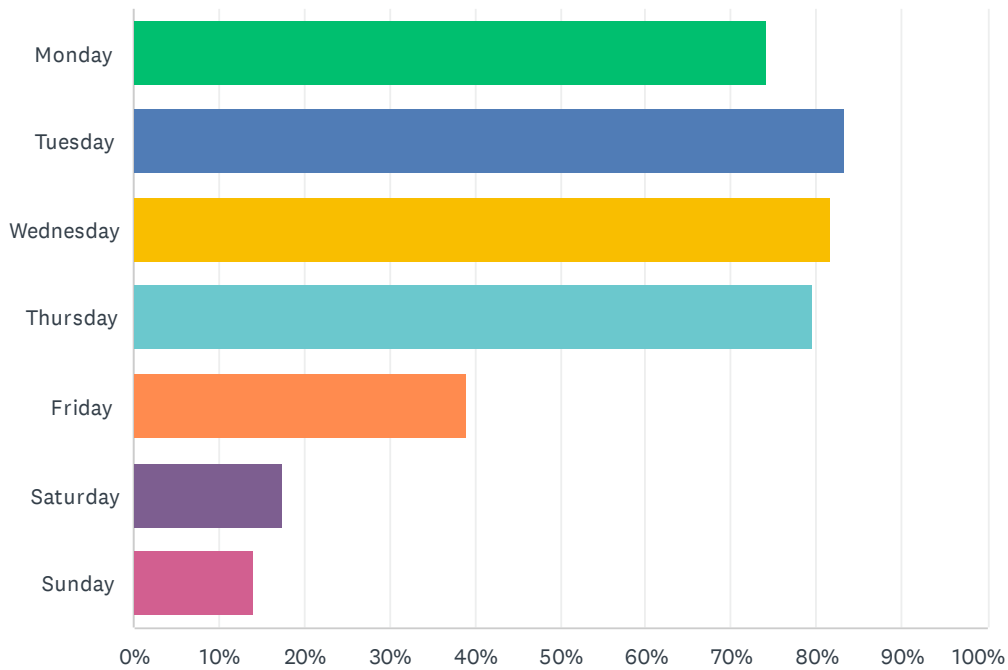

### Q10 What days do you prefer to take classes? (Select all that apply.)

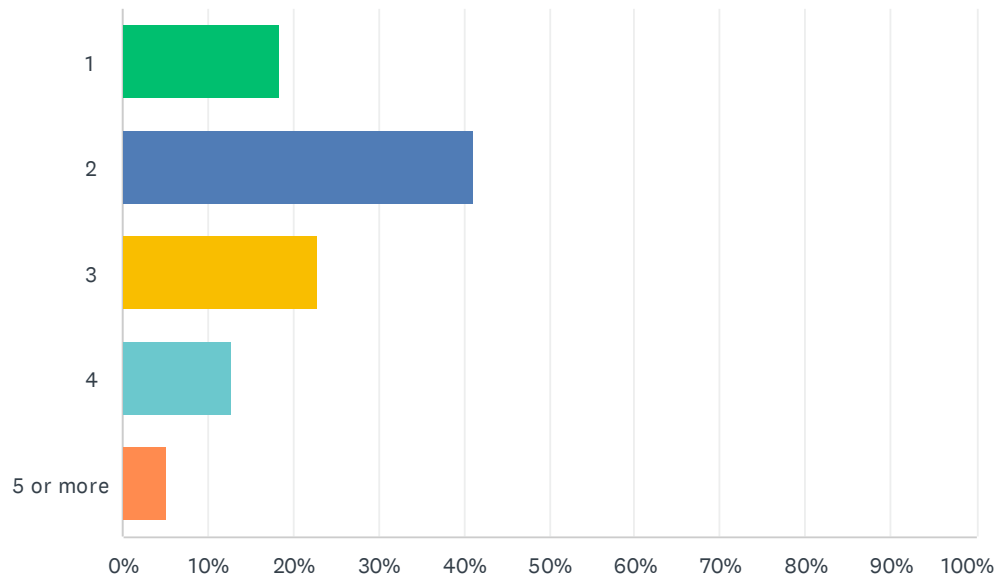

## Q11 How many days per week would you like to attend classes?

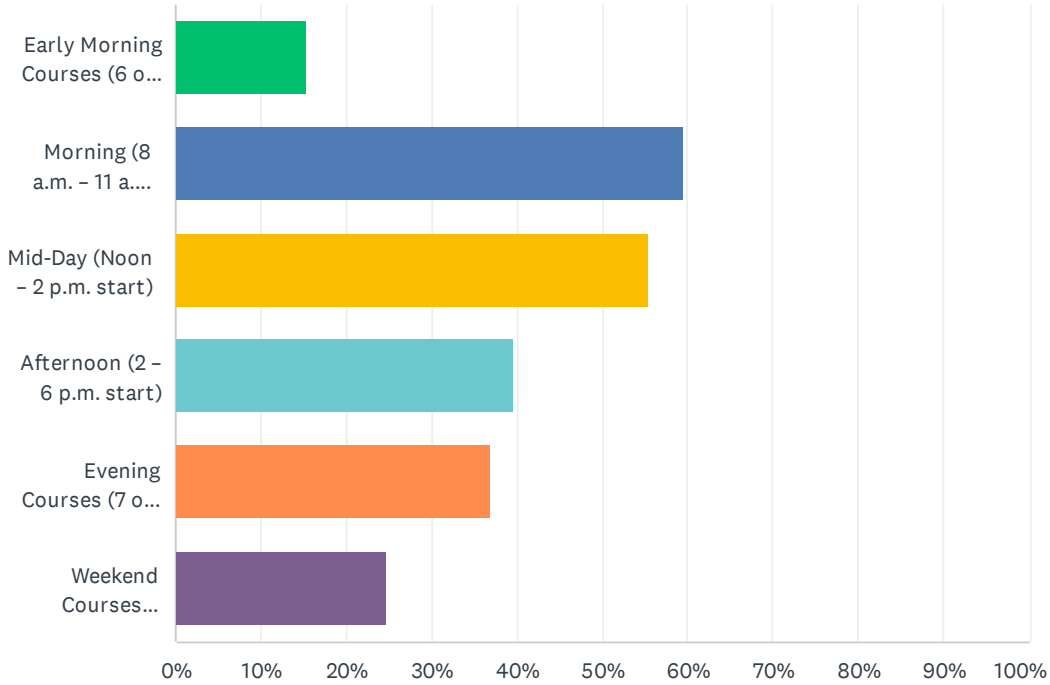

## Q12 Which offerings would you consider if available? (Select all that apply.)

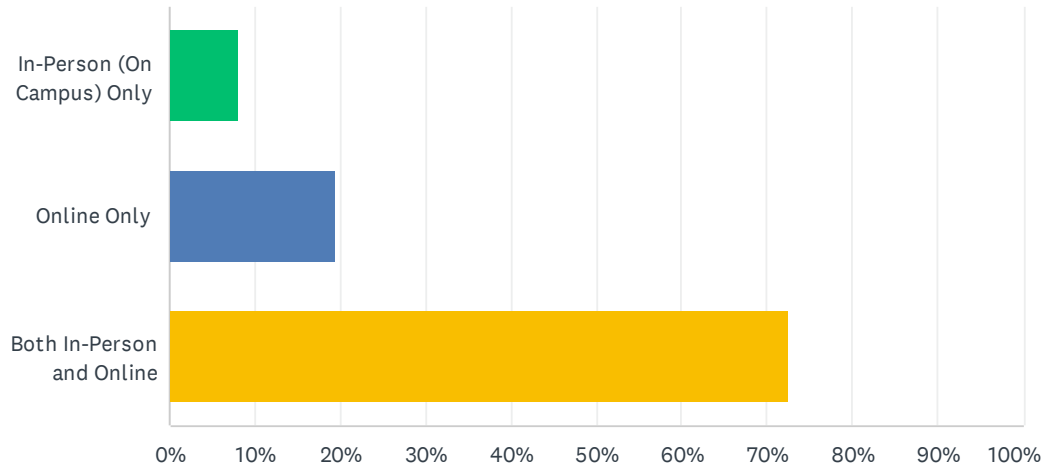

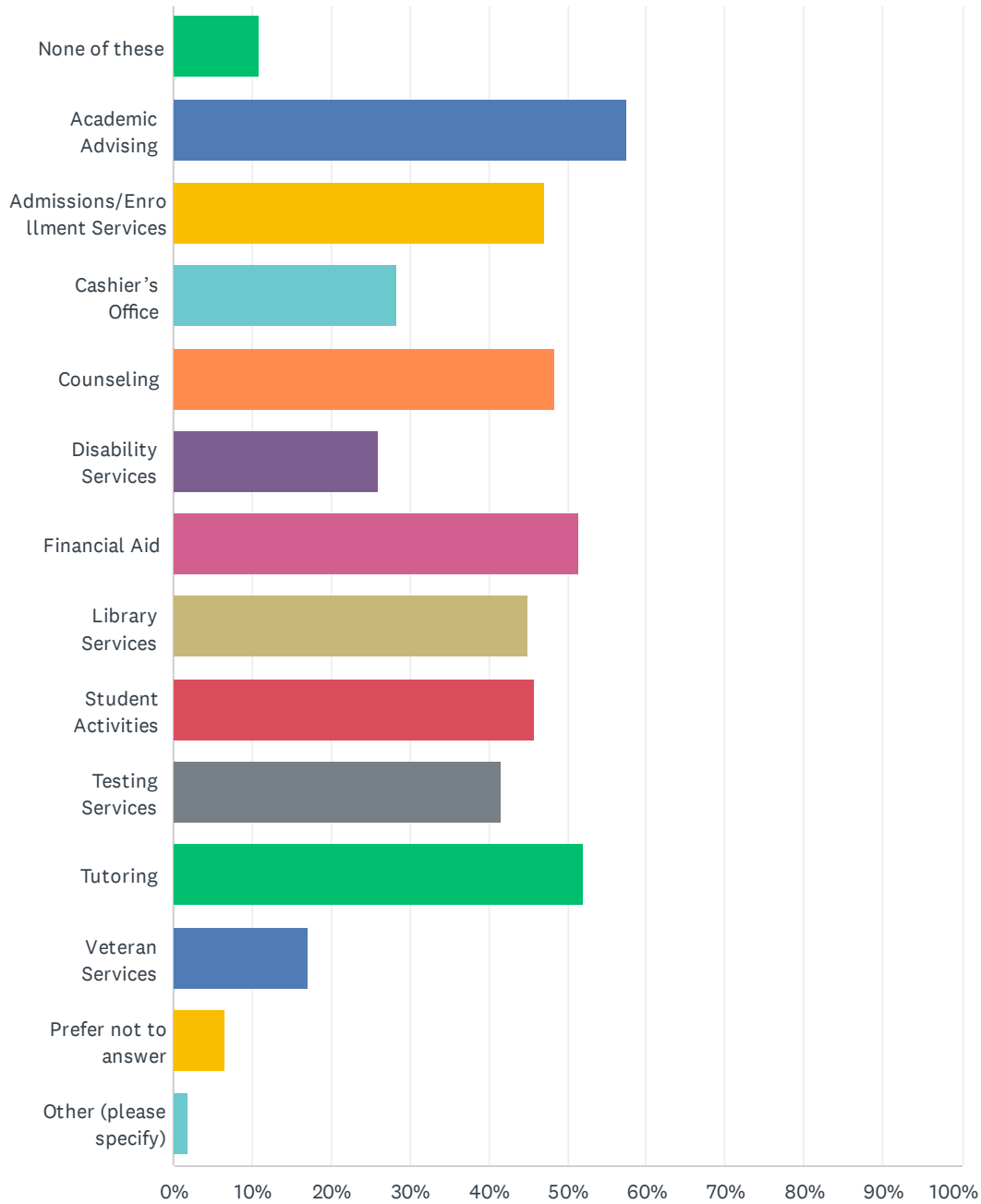

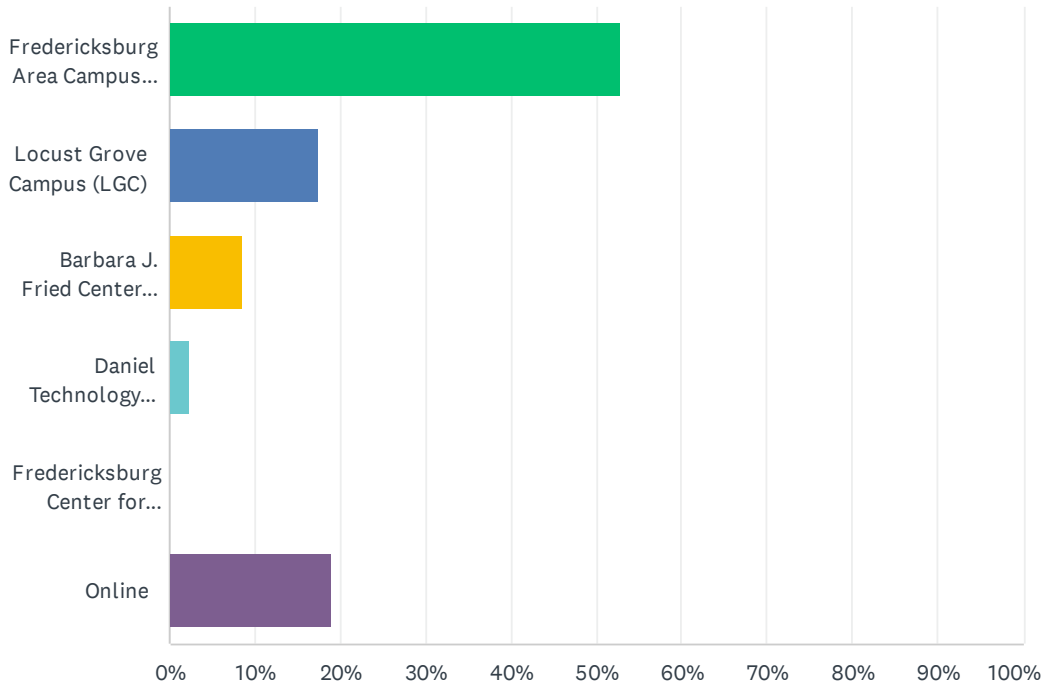

## Q15 What is your primary campus location?

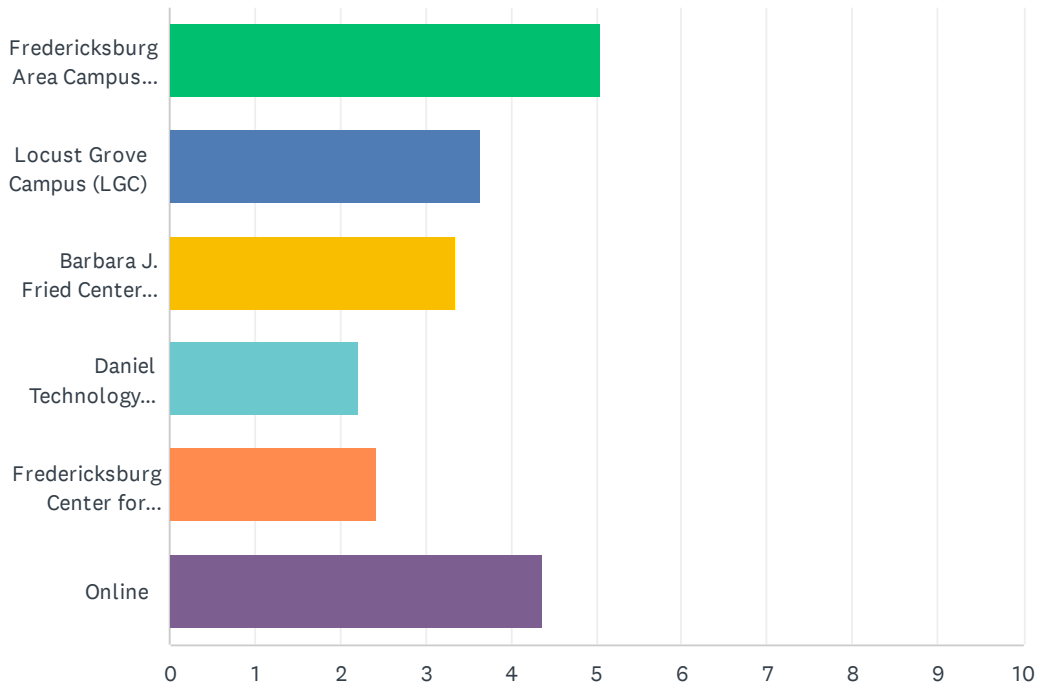

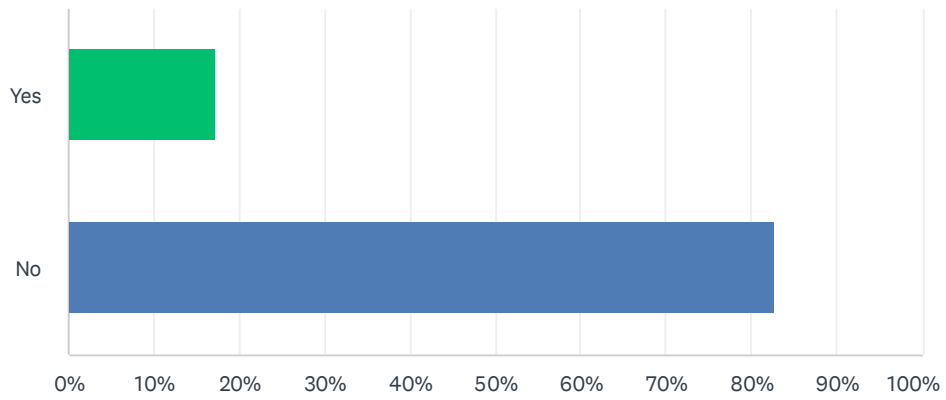

## Q19 Are you of Hispanic or Latino/a origin?

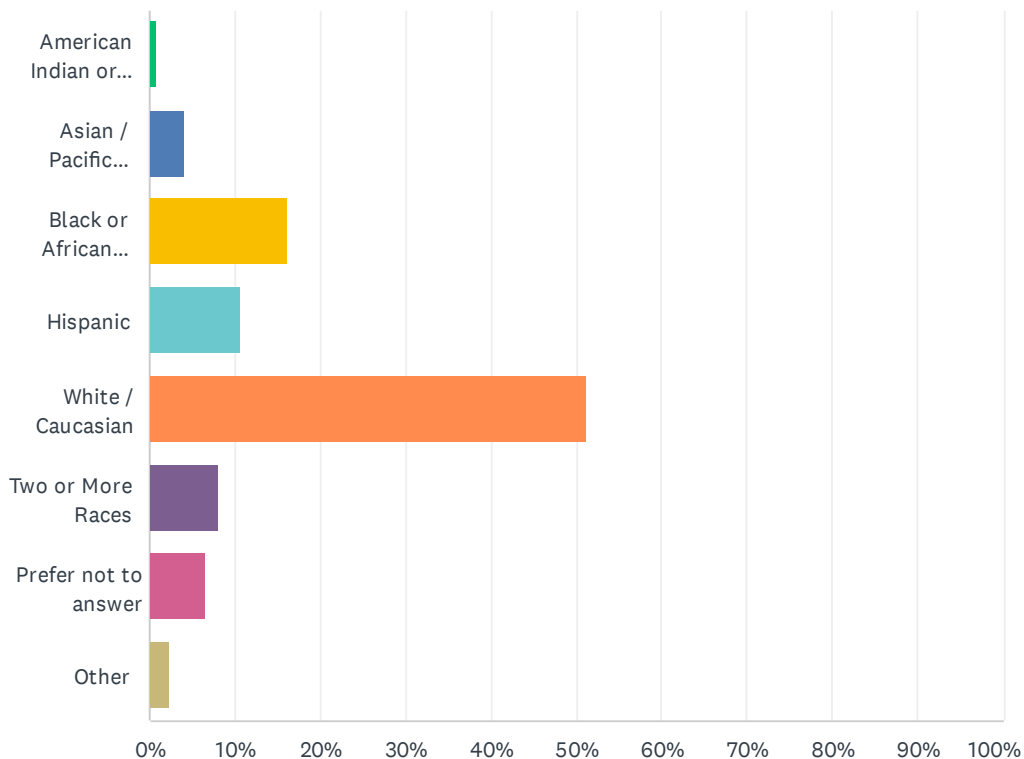

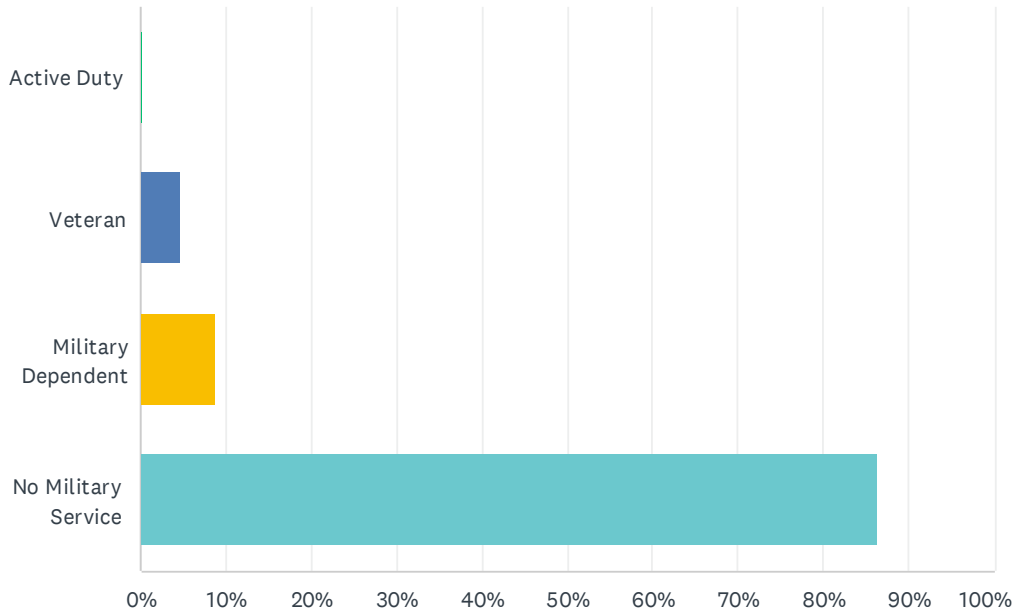

## Q21 What is your military status?

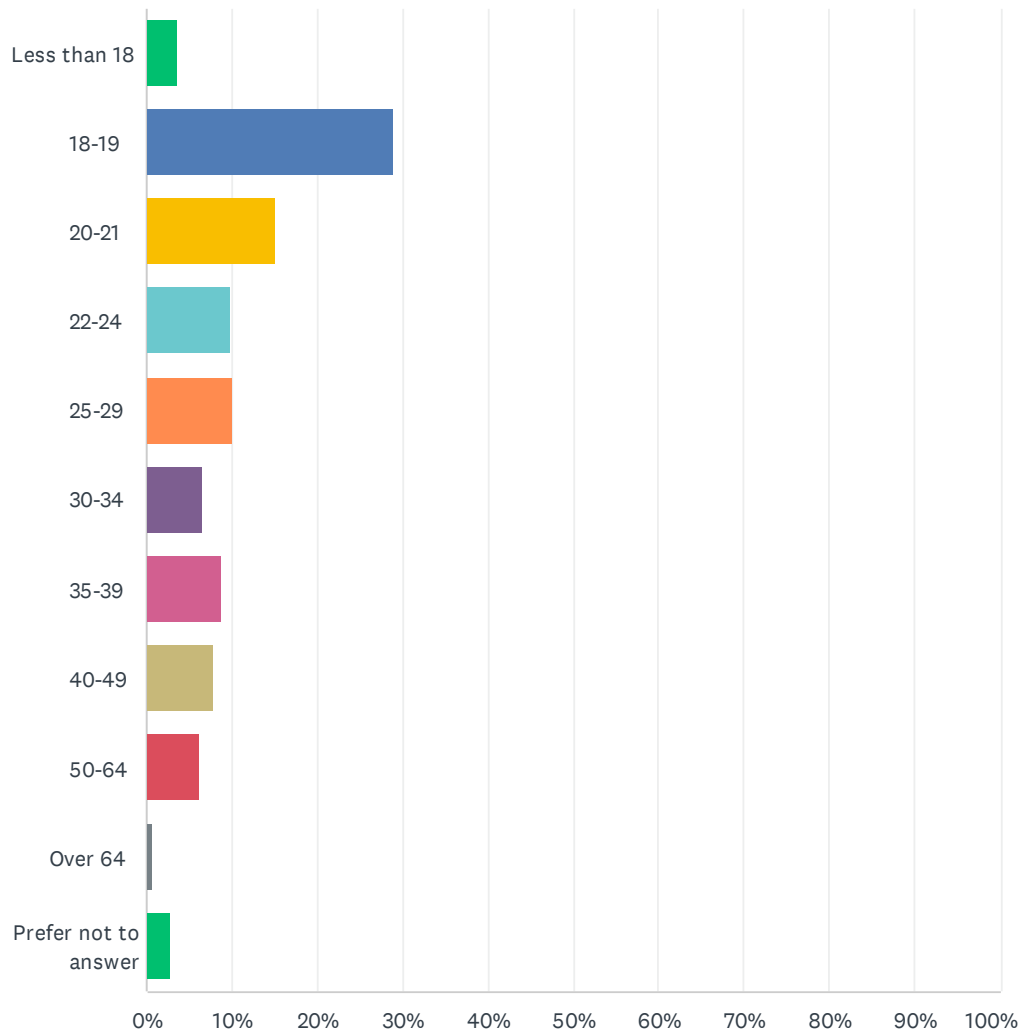
