

Student Tuition Assistance Agreement for Senior Citizens

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY

“Senior Citizens Higher Education Act of 1977” amended 2003

- A. To be eligible for free tuition and fees for credit courses, part-time or full-time, a person must meet the following criteria.
1. Be 60 years of age or older.
 2. Be a legal resident of Virginia.
 3. Had a taxable income not exceeding \$15,000 for Federal Income tax purposes for the year preceding the year in which enrollment is sought.
 4. Be admitted to the college as a student.
- B. To be eligible for free tuition for audit of credit courses or for taking non-credit courses (not exceeding three courses per semester), a person must meet the following criteria:
1. Be 60 years of age or older.
 2. Be a legal resident of Virginia.
 3. Be admitted to the college as a student.
