Profile:

Four-year public university located in Newport News. Youngest comprehensive university in Virginia. Enrollment of 4800. Nationally ranked as one of top 10 "up-and-coming" liberal arts colleges by *U.S. News & World Report*. Known for its small classes and state-of-the-art facilities. Majors with highest enrollment: business administration/management, psychology, public administration, communication studies, biology/environmental science, social work.

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate of AA&S transfer program with 3.5+ GPA. Completion of General Education requirements is considered satisfied with possible exception of foreign language which must be completed through 201 either at GCC or at CNU. Grade transferability: C. Maximum number of transferable credits accepted: 66. Acceptance into some CNU degree programs is competitive and further acceptance into those programs/departments is necessary.

Regular Transfer Admissions:

CNU looks for a 3.0 GPA, completion of at least one college level course in English and one college level course in math such as MTH 151,152 or Statistics. Will consider transfer students with as little as 12-15 credits. CNU requires full time enrollment (12+ credits). University housing is open to transfer students on space available basis.
