Profile:

Located at three suburban campuses in Northern Virginia, GMU is one of the largest transfer institutions in the country with approximately 3,000 transfer students entering each year. 18,000+ undergraduate students. Over 70% of students commute, but campus housing continues to grow. *Kiplinger's* named GMU to its top 100 "Best Values in Public Colleges" for 2009-2010. Strongest programs include Economics, Public Policy, Government, Communications, and Information Technology. Diverse student body.

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S transfer program with a minimum 2.75 GPA at the time of application and upon graduation. The minimum cumulative GCC GPA increases to 2.85 effective fall 2012 and to 3.0 effective fall 2013. Applicants must earn a minimum of 30 transferrable credit hours at GCC. These 30 credit hours must include ENG 111 & 112 and math (151, 152, 173, 174, 240, 271). The ENG and MTH courses must be earned with grades of C or better in each course and should be completed prior to the last semester at GCC. While a Letter of Intent is not required for students planning to use the GAA, <http://admissions.gmu.edu/transfer/masonNvccIntentLetter.asp>, it is requested for students who have completed at least 30 and no more than 45 credits at GCC. It's an online form for your reference and no counselor signature is required.
