Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S transfer program with a cumulative GPA of 2.5+. Lowest grade transferable: C. Letter of intent required after a minimum of 15 credits but before applying for graduation at GCC. For regular admissions, students must complete 12+ semester hours of **college-level** work.
