## Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S transfer program with a cumulative GPA of 3.0. Complete English Composition with grade of B or higher. Grade transferability = C. General education requirements will be considered completed with exception of course in gender studies, course addressing a culture outside of the U.S. or Europe, course in global issues, and foreign language requirement. Recommendation, personal statement, and high school transcript required. SAT/ACT scores optional. May transfer maximum of 62 credits.
