Private, not-for-profit university founded in 1978 by evangelist Pat Robertson. Located in Virginia Beach. Emphasis on distance learning programs. Student body: 1000 undergraduates, 3000 graduate students. The School of Undergraduate Studies, which began in Fall 2007, is designed primarily (but not exclusively) for non-traditional (adult) students who wish to complete undergraduate degrees. Two, eight-week sessions per semester. Bachelor's degrees are offered in Communication (including an emphasis in Animation), Global Business, Interdisciplinary Studies (Elementary Education), Government, Psychology, Organizational Leadership & Management, Religious Studies and English. ROTC available.

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate of a transfer-oriented degree with 2.5+ GPA. Maximum of 63 credits may be transferred. Advanced standing may be awarded through CLEP testing and Armed Services experience. General Education requirements are considered completed. Course transferability: C.
