Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. Students with an Applied Science degree (AAS) will have all VCCS courses with a grade of C or better accepted for transfer. Students can transfer a maximum of 90 credit hours. Credit will be awarded for CLEP tests, corporate and military training, life and work experience/prior learning.
