

UNIVERSITY OF RICHMOND **Weekend College at Germanna (FAC)**

Profile:

Private, nationally recognized university in Richmond. The Weekend College through U of R's School of Continuing Studies is designed for working professionals who seek an accelerated interdisciplinary liberal arts bachelor's degree. Classes are held at GCC Friday evenings, Saturday mornings, and online. Students are organized into cohort groups that proceed together through ten, six-credit hour classes. Students take one class at a time but enroll in 12 credits each semester.

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from GCC AA&S transfer program with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. Course transferability requires C. Transfer students will be designated as junior-level students, but will be required to complete any unfilled general education requirements. Foreign language is not required.
