Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from GCC AA&S transfer degree program, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.4, foreign language through 202. Precalculus (MTH 163 and 164) and MTH 151 will **not** satisfy math requirement, but MTH 152 and statistics are acceptable. Earn a C or better in every GCC course taken. Must complete ENG 111 and 112 with a letter grade of "B" or better. Students who took ENG 111 and 112 in high school through Dual Enrollment must take ENG 210, Advanced Composition, with a grade of B or better. A Non-Western Perspective course is required (REL 237, SOC 211,212, 266 and ENG 253, 254 meet this requirement). SAT or ACT scores required, but scores will be waived for students who have been out of high school for five + years. Students who transfer to UVA are expected to enroll as full time students carrying average of 15 credit hours per semester. Letter of Intent not required. CLEP exams not accepted.
