Profile:

Located in Richmond, VCU is Virginia's largest metropolitan university with an enrollment of nearly 23,000 undergraduates. Offers 56 baccalaureate degrees. School of the Arts is ranked by *U.S. News & World Report* as one of the top six art schools in the nation. Majors with highest enrollment: biological and physical sciences, communications, journalism, psychology.

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S transfer-oriented program with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or students planning on transferring without earning a transfer oriented associates degree may alternatively gain guaranteed admission into VCU with the completion of a VCCS General Education Certificate assuming the following criteria is met:

- Minimum GPA requirement = 2.5 with no grades below a C transferring to VCU (i.e., students should repeat D or F grades at community college)
- Writing requirement = complete 3 writing courses at community college: ENG 111, ENG 112, and ENG 210

VCU accepts a maximum of 63 credits. Course transferability: C. Acceptance in some degree programs is competitive and students must meet those program or department requirements. "VCCS-VCU Student Letter of Interest in Transferring" must be submitted prior to graduation from GCC. Click on this link for more information on the GAA and to access the letter:
