Virginia Tech's highly regarded College of Engineering is one of eight Virginia Tech colleges located in Blacksburg. In 2008, *U.S. News & World Report* ranked the undergraduate College of Engineering 14th in the nation and 8th among public universities. 14 engineering disciplines include Aerospace and Ocean, Chemical, Civil and Environmental, Electrical and Computer, Mechanical, Industrial, and Mining.

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Students are guaranteed admission to the College of Engineering for the Summer or Fall semester after completing Germanna's A.S. in Engineering degree with at least a 3.0 GPA. General education requirements are considered met. Admission is to General Engineering: admission to a specific department is subject to space availability and specific departmental entrance requirements. Eligible students will be admitted to alternate engineering majors if the first choice of major is not available. Drafting and engineering technology courses will not be counted for academic credit in transfer.
