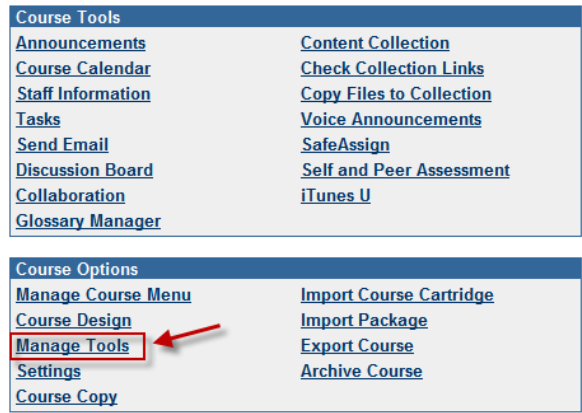
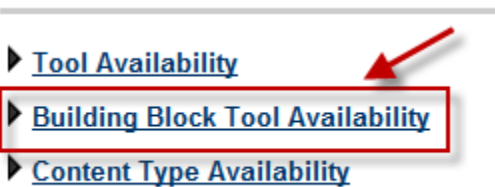


How to make Respondus Lockdown Browser options available in your Blackboard course

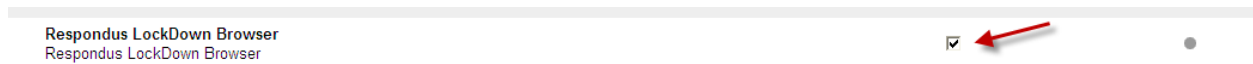
Log into Blackboard and then go into the Control Panel for your course. Once in the Control Panel find 'Manage Tools' in the Course Options module.



On the next screen choose 'Building Block Tool Availability'.



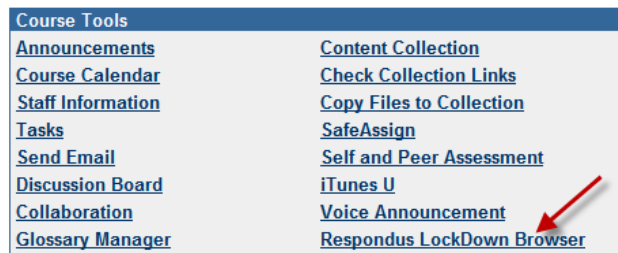
Find the listing for Respondus LockDown Browser and make sure that the box to the right is checked.



Then click Submit.



Now go back to the Control Panel, where you will see a new option for Respondus Lockdown Browser.



Here you will get a list of the tests that you have in your course. It will tell you whether you have already set Respondus LockDown Browser as a requirement or not. If you would like to change the requirements for a particular test click the button, Modify Settings.



Your options are to require the Respondus LockDown Browser or not require the Respondus LockDown Browser. You can also setup a password for the test here.
