## **Middle College Mission**

The mission of the Germanna Community College Middle College Program is to provide a unique learning environment to help our students achieve their academic, career and personal goals.

## **About Middle College**

Middle College is a program designed for individuals between 18-24 years old to help them obtain their GED, earn college credit, develop job skills and complete the Career Readiness Certificate. In addition, Middle College will provide an avenue for students to transition into college courses to work towards a certificate, or degree at Germanna Community College.

## **Middle College students are GCC students.**

Once enrolled in Middle College, the student is entered into the college system and has access to all of the activities and services provided to other Germanna Community College students.

## **Enrollment Criteria**

To be considered for enrollment in Middle College, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 18-24 years old
- Non-graduate from high school
- Score 9.0 or better on Middle College placement test (TABE)
- Complete Middle College application and essay.
- Complete GCC Application for Admission
- Interview with the Director.

## **No Tuition or Fees**

Middle College is FREE to applicants who qualify.

All books, materials, testing fees and tuition costs are paid by Middle College.

## **Middle College Class Offerings**

Classes are Monday through Wednesday and both morning and evening classes are available.

## **The Enrollment Process**

Applicants should call (540) 834-1062 to arrange a Middle College placement test date and time.

Once the student takes the Middle College placement test and qualifies, applications for admission into Middle College and Germanna Community College must be completed and submitted for review.

Once the applications are accepted, the applicant schedules a time to meet with the director of the program to discuss academic, career and personal goals.

At that point, the admission process is complete and the student is officially enrolled in the program.
