Policy 40170: Employee Access to Non-Credit Classes

1. Purpose

This policy establishes criteria and procedures for allowing employees to take non-credit courses related to their position at the college, free of charge.

2. Policy

- 2.1.** Employees will be allowed to take classes related to their jobs, free of charge, on a space available basis. Priority will be given to paying customers of the Center for Workforce and Community Education.
- 2.2.** Exception. Employees will be charged the stated registration fee for any class that has a per person fee paid to the vendor/instructor.

3. Procedures

- 3.1.** Complete the Center for Workforce and Community Education registration form.
- 3.2.** Complete a supervisor sign-off form with which the supervisor agrees the class is related to the employee's job. This form may be obtained from a Center for Workforce office.
- 3.3.** It is the supervisor's prerogative to decide if an employee can take a class during the day.
- 3.4.** Contact the appropriate Workforce office two business days in advance of the class to confirm space availability.
