FOR APPLICANTS TO NON-CREDIT CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE (CNA) AND PHLEBOTOMY PROGRAMS

NEW! This class is required for individuals applying for admission to Workforce non-credit CNA and Phlebotomy programs. The application process to these programs is competitive and selective. Completion of this course and a qualifying score on the CRC assessment is part of the admissions criteria.

This class includes:

- (a) On the first class meeting date, an introduction to the Career Readiness Certificate (CRC), including what it is, what it means, how to attain it, and a review of types of test questions.
- (b) On the second meeting date, administration of the CRC assessments. Assessments include: reading for information, locating information, and applied mathematics.

You will receive your CRC assessment results approximately three weeks after taking the assessment.
