

Certified Nurse Aide Training At Germanna's Center for Workforce & Community Education



CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE – WORKFORCE CREDENTIAL \$850

The Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) workforce credential program is now being offered and is accepting applications for upcoming classes.

This 120-hour state-approved program is designed to prepare the student to take the Nurse Aide in Virginia certification test. Upon successful completion of the course, individuals will be eligible for employment in a variety of health care settings.

The CNA admissions process is competitive and the course is rigorous. As part of the application process, applicants first need to complete the CRC Health Care Orientation class (HLTH 2259), and attain a satisfactory score on the CRC (Career Readiness Certificate) assessment. Check with our office for Orientation class and testing dates and times.

Applicants also need to provide documentation of various health related credentials to verify their current medical and dental health and provide verification of immunizations.

Additional fees apply for required background check and liability insurance, books, health insurance, and supplies. Clinical rotations are scheduled for a variety of shifts between 7am – 11pm at various healthcare facilities.
