The course prepares participants to successfully complete the FAA private pilot written examination. Upon successful completion, students will receive a logbook endorsement to take the FAA private pilot written exam.

Participants will also need to purchase the curriculum materials from the instructor at the first class session at a cost of approximately \$250.
