

American Psychological Association (APA) Paper Checklist for College Writers

The *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, Seventh Edition* provides specific guidelines for formatting papers in the sciences and social sciences. This checklist serves as a guide for self-editing tool that allows students to confirm that their papers meet the requirements of APA formatting.

Basic Formatting

- Have you used Arial 11 pt., Calibri 11 pt., Times New Roman 12 pt., or Lucida Sans Unicode 10 pt. font for the entire paper? NOTE: If you are unsure of the font guideline for the assignment, it is recommended that you review the assignment guidelines or contact your instructor.
- □ Are the margins 1 inch on the sides, top, and bottom of the paper?
- □ Has your line spacing been set to double spacing (2.0)?
- Has the space after each paragraph been removed from the entire document? (See the Academic Center for Excellence's handouts <u>APA Formatting in Word 2016</u> or <u>Google</u>
 <u>Docs: Instructions for Formatting an Academic Paper</u> for additional information on formatting line spacing)
- □ Have you correctly used section headings if they are required?

Headers

□ Is the page number right-aligned in the header box?

Title Page

Are the title and subtitle centered and bolded, and are they 3-4 lines from the top of the page?



- Did you include your name, the college's name, the course information, your instructor's name, and the due date double-spaced? Is your name located one blank double space from the title and subtitle?
- □ Are the required items centered between the left and right page margins?

Abstract

Is the instructor requiring an abstract?

- □ Is the abstract written on a separate page?
- □ Is the word "Abstract" centered and bolded at the top of the page?
- □ Is the entire abstract paragraph left-aligned and not indented?
- Does the abstract summarize the main points of the paper?
- □ Is the abstract **different** from the introductory paragraph?
- Does the abstract meet the length requirement set by the instructor?
- □ Has the indentation been removed from the first line of the abstract?
- □ Are "Keywords" included after the abstract paragraph if instructor desires them?

Body

- □ Is the title of the paper repeated before the introductory paragraph?
- □ Is the title centered and bolded?
- □ Are the first lines of all the body paragraphs indented?
- □ Are all section headings bolded and formatted according to APA's level headings?



Did you check to ensure that there is only <u>one</u> double space between the title and the introductory paragraph and only <u>one</u> double space between each of the following paragraphs?

In-text Citations

- Are parenthetical citations being used? For examples, see the Academic Center for Excellence's <u>APA Format Guide</u>.
- □ Are all quotes and paraphrases of external sources cited within the text?

Block Quotations

Has a quotation of 40 words or more been used?

If you selected "Yes," please continue with this section. If you selected "No," please move to the References section of the handout.

- Does the block quotation begin on a new line?
- □ Is the entire block quotation indented half an inch?
- □ Have quotation marks been <u>omitted</u> from the block quotation?
- □ Is the in-text citation located **after** the final punctuation for the block quotation?
- □ Is there a double space between the end of the block quotation and the next line?

References

- Does the References section start on a separate page?
- □ Is the heading, References, centered and bolded at the top of the page?
- Are <u>all</u> of the sources used in the paper, excluding any personal communications, included on the References page?
- □ Are all of the references in alphabetical order?
- □ Are all of the references formatted with hanging indents?



- □ Is each reference double spaced?
- □ Is each reference correctly formatted in APA style according to the reference type? For examples, see the Academic Center for Excellence's <u>APA Format Guide</u>.
